THE AMHE WILL CELEBRATE ITS 48TH ANNUAL CONVENTION DURING THIS WEEKEND OF JULY 30TH THRU AUGUST 1ST, 2021.

CONTRARY TO PAST CONVENTIONS WHEN WE CHOSE A TRAVEL DESTINATION AND STAYED THERE FOR AT LEAST A WEEK, ATTENDING LECTURES AND PARTICIPATING IN SEVERAL Randonnees AND ARTISTIC ACTIVITIES, THIS YEAR, SAME AS LAST YEAR, WE WILL CONTINUE TO OBSERVE THE PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES IMPOSED ON US BY THE COVID -19 PANDEMIC AND WILL OFFER THE CONFERENCE VIA ZOOM...
